Thursday 21 January 11:30 am – 1:15 pm:

« Elles » Women artists of the 20th Century.

Exhibition at the Musée d'art moderne at the Centre Georges Pompidou.

(until May 24, 2010)

This is the first time in history that a major art museum has given over its entire exhibition space to art created by women. This highly original display is organized in broad themes reflecting Feminist history and issues: "Pioneers", "Fire at Will", "Body as Slogan", "Eccentric Abstraction", "A Room of One's Own" … All the great names, periods and styles of modern and contemporary art are featured: Shirley Jaffe, Sonia Delaunay, Joan Mitchell, Natalia Gontcharova, Hannah Höch, Frida Kahlo, Susanne Valadon, Diane Arbus, Dora Maar, Niki de Saint Phalle, Dorothea Tanning, Sophie Calle and many more. This is a wonderful opportunity to revise and fill in your history of 20th century Feminism in the arts.
